Dear Parents,

Everyone seems to be adjusting to the "new normal". I am very proud of our students and teachers who have adjusted to all that is different. I am sure the students like to wear their own clothes on gym days. As you know you will have an opportunity to order some gym clothing. Information will be sent soon. This is optional; you do not have to buy anything new. Students may just Dress Down. According to our handbook the Dress Down Day Dress Code states: Students may wear: jeans, sneakers, short socks; shorts no shorter than three inches above the knee, sweatshirts, and jogging suits. Students may not wear: flip - flop sandals, no open back shoes, tank tops, t-shirts with inappropriate writing or design, tennis shoes that convert to roller skates, biker shorts, pajama pants, low cut tops, clothing that is extremely tight, or hats.



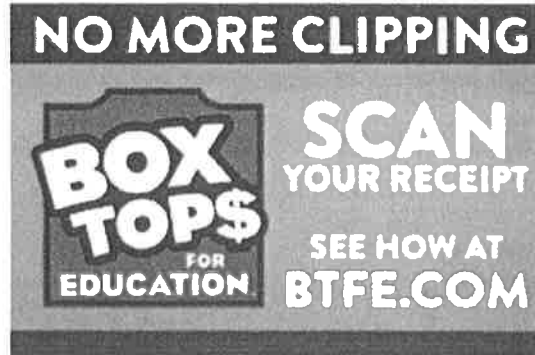

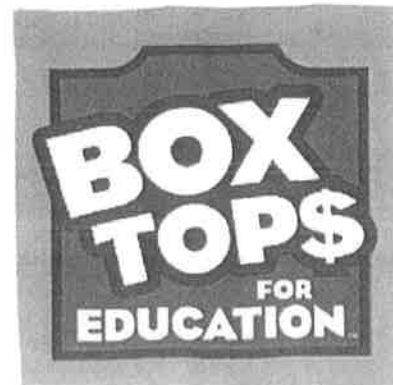
