Dear Parents,

We made it through our first month! I want to thank all of you for your help and cooperation as we journey through this year. 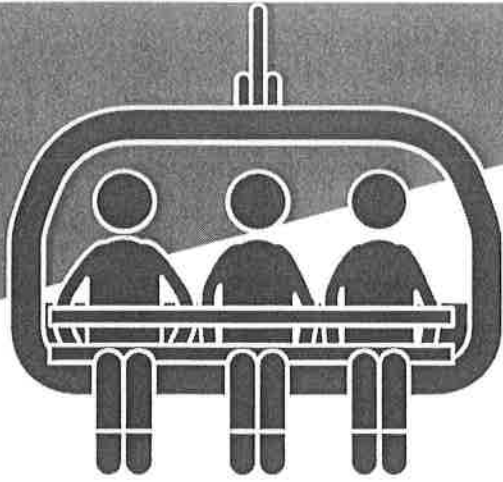
Hello Immaculate Conception School Families,

Dear Group Organizers and Parents,

Another ski and snowboard season is in the planning stages at Kissing Bridge! Amid these challenging times; outdoor activities at Kissing Bridge will remain a safe, affordable solution for your groups and families!

All lessons will require advance on-line reservations

Student Club Group lessons will be offered on Thursday and Friday evening as well as all day Saturday and Sunday. Student clubs will choose their lesson time from this new availability. Ski and Snowboard lessons will be offered for students of all levels at each lineup time. Students must be 8 years of age and older and a minimum of 48 inches tall to participate in Group lessons.

Student Club lesson times:

Thursday & Friday: 3pm, 4pm, 5pm, 6pm, 7pm

Saturday: 1pm, 2pm, 3pm, 4pm, 5pm

Sunday: 1pm, 2pm, 3pm

Students wanting KB Cruisers lessons in clubs are advised to purchase a KB Cruisers card as an addition to their Student Club tuition. Advanced reservations for KB Cruisers is required. Students in our Mountain classes must demonstrate that they can load and unload the chairlift independently and pull down the safety bar by themselves. Students in Mountain classes may be riding the lifts alone, with other class members or with general public skiers and riders. For KB Cruisers Mountain skiers and riders who cannot demonstrate that they can ride the lifts independently, their lessons will be taught on slopes serviced by the Magic Carpet and a newly installed handle tow at the base of the Coal Chute area. The Coal Chute area will be an enhanced learning area for our Mountain skiers and riders to include a small Terrain Park as well as other Terrain based learning features to challenge and improve on their skills.

To comply with social distancing recommendations, the KB Cruisers programs will now be 1.5 hours long without an indoor cocoa break. Sessions will have limited enrollment. Additional sessions on weekends have been added to safely distance our groups.
