Dear Parents,

I want to thank all of the parents who had their children tested last week. I know it was a frustrating week with long lines, rain, less than eager children, and inconclusive test results. Your participation was greatly appreciated. I know many of you, like me, want to keep our school open and have students in the building.

The students and teachers seemed to have adjusted to the remote learning. It is good to see everyone back in school this week.

Our plans call for our last day of school before Christmas to be Friday, December 18. It will be a full day. We will resume in person schooling on Monday, January 4. In order to comply with our testing requirements we need to test a total of 20% of our population each month while we are in the Orange Zone. We may have to test 10% during the week of January 4 and another 10% later in the month. I will be asking for volunteers before the testing begins. I am working on a couple of options for our testing. Everything hinges on availability of tests, scheduling options, and constant guideline changes. I am hoping we can do it here with parents and Mrs. Baritot assisting our students. As soon as I get the specifics, I will let you know.

Please be very careful over the Christmas holidays because if we get cases, we may be forced to shut down in spite of all of our efforts.
