Dear Parents,


Thank You for your very generous donations to Bethany Humphrey's fundraising campaign for cancer research. Today Grades 1,2, and 5 are Dressing Down and tomorrow (March 19) the rest of the school. The Student Council is having a basket raffle to raise money for Bethany's project. See the enclosed flyer. As I mentioned last week we are having Mass tomorrow in honor of the Feast of St. Joseph. Even though we have a Dress Down Day, please no shorts for Mass.

As part of the Smart School Bonds Act our school is receiving around \$50,000.00 for technology. This act was passed a few years ago to allow all schools to upgrade their technology. Most of our interactive boards are old and three had to be replaced within the last year. Some of the remaining boards are experiencing some problems. Over Easter we are going to be replacing many of the boards using the funds from the Smart School Bonds Act. A representative from the company is giving the teachers an in depth presentation on how to use the boards on Monday, April 12. This representative will work with the teachers individually as they learn the fine points of the board. **For the students, Monday, April 12 will be an additional day of Easter vacation. School will resume on Tuesday, April 13.**

Any time a positive case of Covid is reported to the school, I send out a letter informing you of a new case. The Health Department is notified and each school does a daily report to the state on the " Covid19 report card". I want to thank the families that have been honest and have let the school know of cases within their own families. I know there are rumors circulating that there are more cases of Covid within our school community and people are not being honest because it may jeopardize their Easter vacations, places of employment, recreation and sporting opportunities, etc. I can only report what has been reported to the school. Some students are absent from school because they may feel uncomfortable attending in person at this time, others may be quarantined because of a family member or possible exposure. Some do not want to be tested. I share in your frustrations that not everyone views things the way we think they should. Please note also that remote instruction is not as simple as turning on a switch. It is difficult if the students do not have their books and other materials. Remote learning is never the same or as good as face to face learning.

The students are receiving their report cards today. Please sign the envelope and return it to school; you may keep the report card. I am scheduling award assemblies for two grades at a time for the end of April for grades 3-8. I have some awards from last year as well as from the first two trimesters of this year. More information to follow.

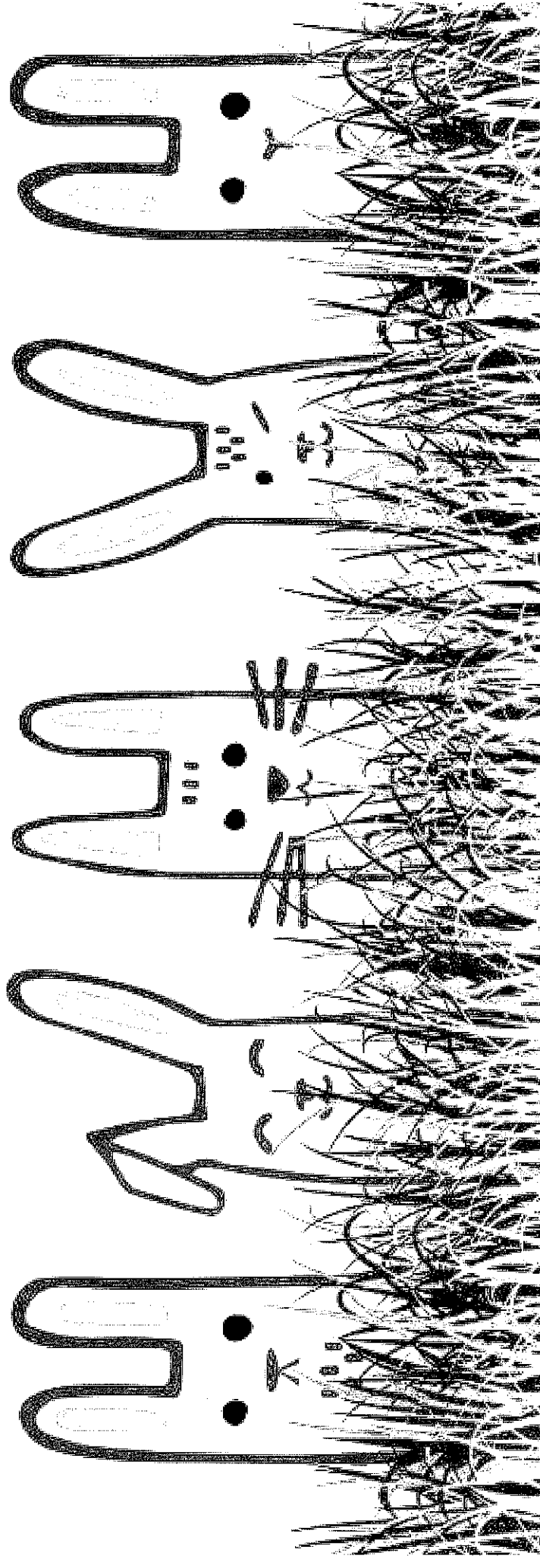

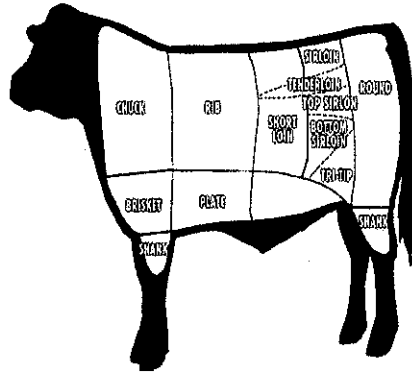
